Capt Natalia K. Cobbins serves as Assistant Professor of Aerospace Studies and Recruiting Officer, Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFROTC), Detachment 159, University of Central Florida. Capt Cobbins leads a team of five to execute all National and Regional Recruiting Strategy efforts for the Detachment. She manages the recruiting budget, administration, instruction, and evaluation activities to develop and support over 150 new accessions per academic year and 250 Air Force cadets attending the university.

Capt Cobbins enlisted in the United States Air Force in October 1998. After Basic Military Training, she attended technical training for Information Management, at Kessler AFB, Mississippi, graduating with honors and attaining the #1 student leader ranking. In 2010, Capt Cobbins cross-trained into her second enlisted career field, Geospatial Intelligence, successively graduating with top academic honors and serving in various positions supporting GWOT and the Pacific Area of Operations. In 2015, Capt Cobbins received her commission through the AF Officer Training School pipeline. She served as a Nuclear and Missile Operations Officer until 2018, when she was selected to crossflow back into Intelligence. She is an AF Intelligence Officer who has worked with NASA, Project West Wing, and numerous three-letter agencies to defend the nation and support our Air. Space, and Cyberspace domains. Capt Cobbins has deployed to and supported many enduring operations in Iraq, Afghanistan, Cuba, Qatar, Kuwait, and the Republic of Korea.
