TECHNICAL SERGEANT JONATHAN R. TAKA

Tech. Sgt. Jonathan R. Taka is an Officer Accessions Instructor, Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFROTC) Detachment 159 at the University of Central Florida. He oversees the cadet life cycle for all personnel actions ranging from medical, physical fitness, security clearance, enlistments and commissioning.

Tech. Sgt. Taka was born in Alexandria, La., but raised in Jacksonville, N.C. He graduated high school in 2008, and enlisted in the Air Force November 2010, attended technical training at Fort Leonard Wood, Miss., and graduated May 2011 as a Pavements and Construction Equipment Apprentice.

Prior to being an Officer Accessions Instructor, he was stationed at Shaw Air Force Base, S.C. Tech. Sgt. Taka served as the Section Chief, Requirements & Optimization where he led 34 engineers from 6 different Air Force Specialty Codes managing the base's 1,100 facilities worth \$2.95 billion. He was also selected by the Mission Support Group Commander to be the Executive Administrative Assistant. While assigned to Nellis AFB, he was attached to the 820th Rapid Engineer Deployable Heavy Operation Repair Squadron Engineers (RED HORSE) Squadron as a Special Capabilities Instructor



specializing in water well drilling where he authored a drilling curriculum, training 15 active duty & reserve RED HORSE squadrons to perform operations in contingent environments.
